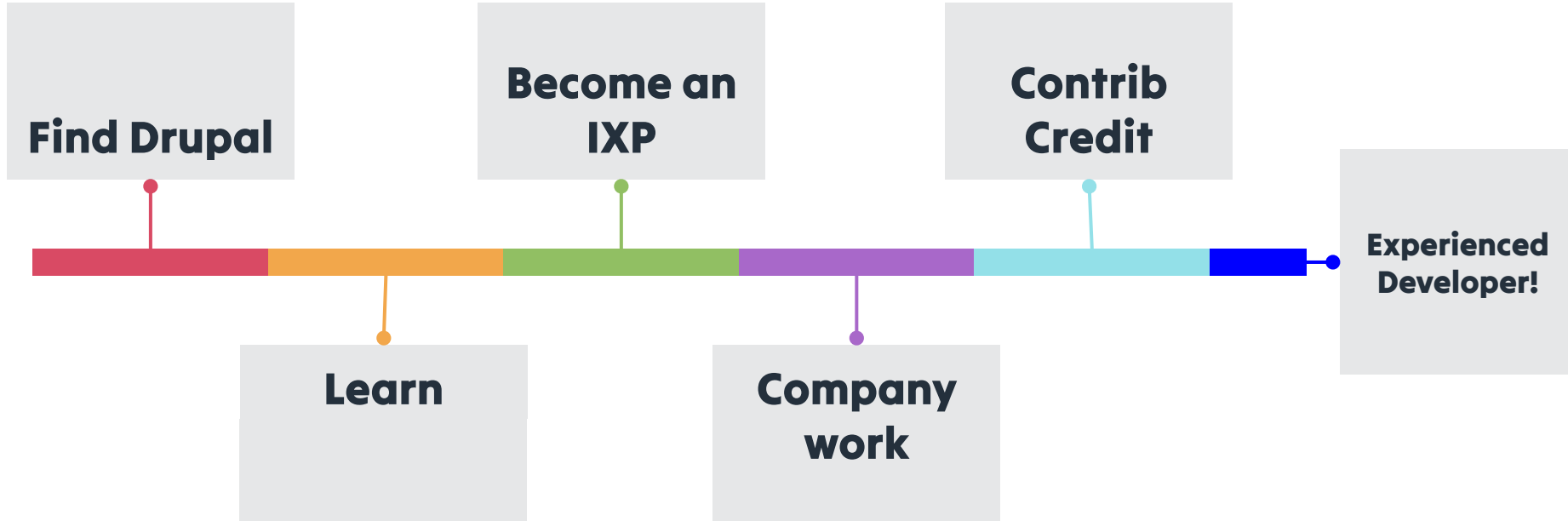

Clear scope, related needs



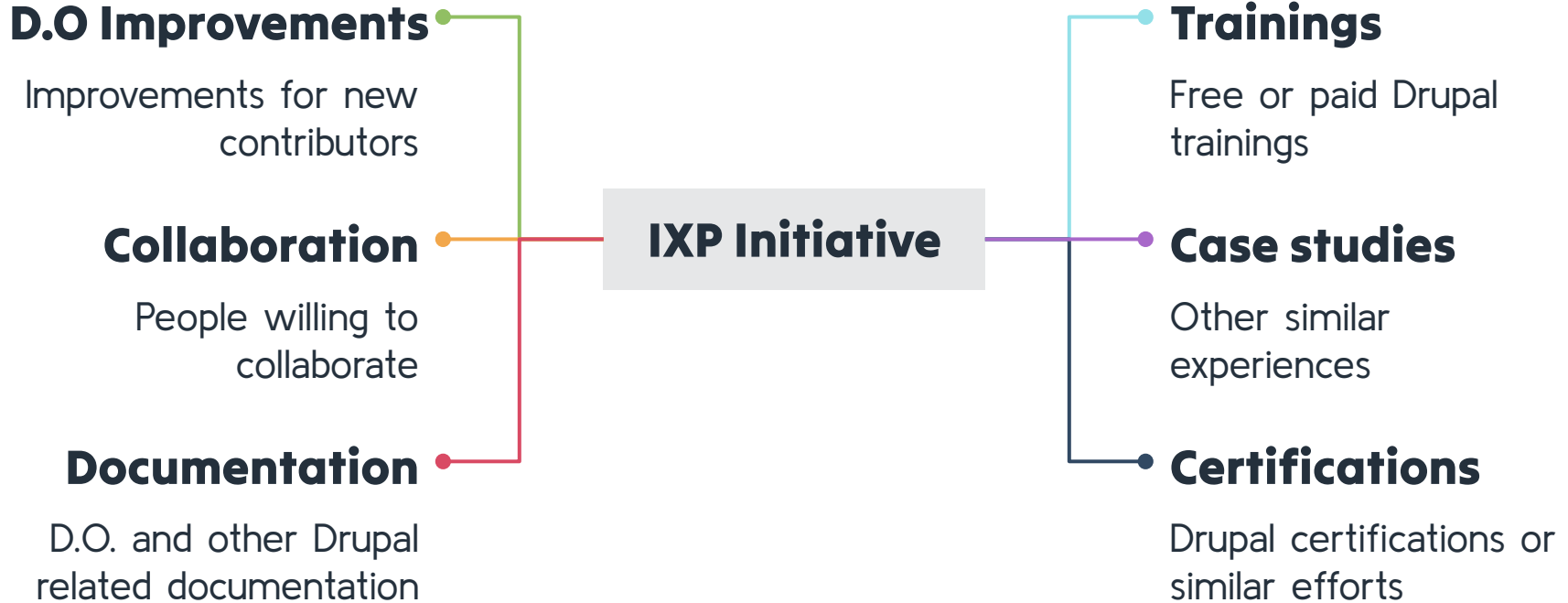
Our Scope



Focus on the basic steps of this process:

- Definition of the skills and core competencies that an IXP should have to be considered for an IXP position.
- A connection method for companies and IXP that allows the start of the process. (jobs.drupal.org)
- Basic conditions of the engagement.
- A set of requirements from the (future) junior dev and the company to demonstrate the end of the process.
- And finally, a reward for the hiring organization, including utilizing the drupal.org contribution system.
